



AMMUNITION

This is still the biggest problem IPSC faces with large matches. To cope with this, we have obtained from the Ministry of Defense authorization allowing for the following:

1.- Import of Ammo

Ammo import will be made by Regions request specifying quantity and caliber. Manufacturer: **Arm Scor**. Ammo will be sold at cost as per enclosed price list but will have to be prepaid to guarantee availability and price. At the range and during the competition, local dealers will also offer ammo for sale but at regular commercial prices and can not guarantee all calibers availability. Any specific caliber and type of ammo not listed, please contact us to request quotation to the factory. Final date for ammo ordering and payment: **February 15, 2005**.

2.- Shipment of ammo (competitors)

Recommend that shipments be made straight to Guayaquil by air/sea freight.

Arrangements are underway to request tax exemptions on shipment of ammo. In as much as there is a possibility to obtain such exemption, can not at this point in time guarantee it. Also, a small custom agents fee will have to be covered by the shipper. In principle all shipments should be addressed to the Organizing Committee WSXIV, however depending on the arrangements we reach with Government Officials, the addressee could change.

In any event, shipped ammo will be stored pending competitors arrival in a military compound.

3.- Sale of firearms and equipment (for sponsors)

Sponsors are authorized to sell goods to competitors only, however, sale of firearms to the general public is prohibited. International competitors will be able to purchase firearms free of local taxes. There will be 24 hour security provided by the police and the military at the range.

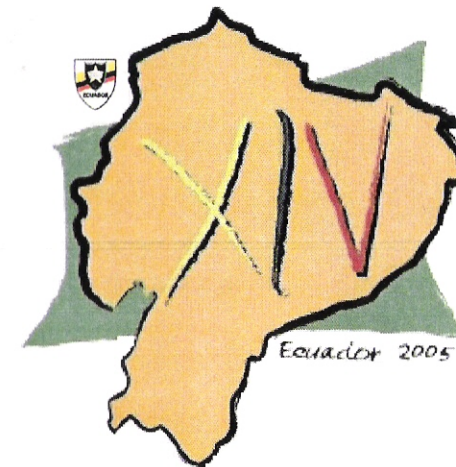
